DO NOT MAKE ANY IDOLS

4 “Do not make for yourselves a god to look like anything that is in heaven above or on the earth below or in the waters under the earth. 5 “Do not worship them or work for them. For I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God. I punish the children, even the great-grandchildren, for the sins of their fathers who hate Me. 6 But I show loving-kindness to thousands of those who love Me and keep My Laws.

Exodus 20:4-6 (NLT)

Idolatry is when something or someone is LOVED, DESIRED, or TREASURED in your heart more than God.

25 They traded the truth of God for a lie. They worshiped and cared for what God made instead of worshiping the God Who made it. He is the One Who is to receive honor and thanks forever. Let it be so.

Romans 1:25

Why do idols fail us?

There’s no lasting POWER in their PROMISE.

6 Some people pour out their silver and gold and hire a craftsman to make a god from it. Then they bow down and worship it! [they made idols] 7 They carry it around on their shoulders, and when they set it down, it stays there. It can’t even move! And when someone prays to it, there is no answer. It can’t rescue anyone from trouble.

Isaiah 46:6-7 (NLT)

8 “Do not forget this! Keep it in mind! Remember this, you guilty ones. 9 Remember the things I have done in the past! For I alone am God! I am God, and there is none like me.

Isaiah 46:8-9 (NLT)

How to Avoid Idolatry

Remember that God alone is our PROVIDER.

24 “No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and be enslaved to money.”

Matthew 6:24 (NLT)

How to Avoid Idolatry

Remember in God alone as our SOURCE.

11 You will show me the way of life, granting me the joy of your presence and the pleasures of living with you forever.

Psalms 16:11 (NLT)

How to Avoid Idolatry

Remember that God alone is WORTHY.

“8 But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.”

Romans 5:8 (NLT)

MAIN POINT - Keep Your Life Focused on CHRIST.
