JESUS WALKS ON WATER.

When evening came, his disciples went down to the sea, 17 got into a boat, and started across the sea to Capernaum. It was now dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them. 18 The sea became rough because a strong wind was blowing. 19 When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were frightened. 20 But he said to them, "It is I; do not be afraid." 21 Then they were glad to take him into the boat, and (immediately) the boat was at the land to which they were going.

John 6:16-21 (ESV)

When storms hit our life:

- We feel ALONE in our storm. (v17)
- We are **<u>BILINDED</u>** by our problems. (v18)
- We are unable to **<u>FIX</u>** it ourselves. (v19)
- We have a hard time **<u>RECOGNIZING</u>** God. (v19)

Truths to remember when caught in a storm:

• Jesus KNOWS where I am and what I'm going through. (v19)

Christ Jesus is at the right hand of God and is also praying for us. Romans 8:34 (NIRV)

• Jesus' word <u>CALMS</u> my fears in the storm. (v20)

I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.

John 14:27 (NLT)

• Jesus always **DELIVERS** me where he's asked me to go. (v21)

"Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me. 2 There is more than enough room in my Father's home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? 3 When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am.

John 14:1-3 (NLT)
